Signs of brain ageing:

1. Disorientation
2. Loss of house training.
3. Irregular sleep patterns
4. Reduce interaction



The importance of worming!

There are different types of internal worms and their effects vary.

Regularly worming from a young age, ideally with a broad-spectrum preparation, is important for all pets.

Signs of internal parasites:

- A dull harsh coat.
- Emaciation
- Diarrhoea and/or vomiting (sometimes, you actually see the worms).
- Poor appetite.
- Depression.
- Anaemia (pale mucous membranes around the eyes and gums).

Broad-spectrum worm medications are only available from your Vet and can come in different types of application:

Profender is a topical all wormer treatment now available for cats.

BONES:

Bones are a fantastic way to keeps your dog's teeth and gums in good health and to keep plaque at bay.

However it is important to use whole bones (with the knuckle on each end).

By using cut bones there is a high risk of dogs wearing down and even breaking their teeth.
